Bike Trips to the Saline Reserves

Stazione Foce, Valli Comacchio

Every Sunday, 10.30 a.m. or 3.30 p.m. until 6th June

Visit the old saline reserves by bike with a guide. The ride is about 7km, along the flatlands typical of this area. It is possible to see a variety of birds and wildlife as well as learn about the interesting historic salt production in Comacchio.

-Tickets cost €10 for adults, €6 children aged 4 – 10, free for children aged 0 – 3

-There is also a €2 charge for entry to the saline reserve for people aged 14 and above.

-It is also possible to hire bikes at the reserve for €5

-The duration of the trip is about 2 hours

Boat Trips around the Delta - Valli di Comacchio

Boat trips have started up again and this particular tour takes you along the tiny natural canals of the delta - a magical oasis filled with a variety of birds including flamingos and other beautiful wildlife. The guide on board will help you discover the uniqueness of this area and the historical fishing aspects of Comacchio.

Tickets cost €13 for adults, €10 for children aged between 7 and 16 and it is free for children up to age 6.
