

## MUSEUMS & GALLERIES IN FERRARA

**Update May 2021**

Museums and galleries have reopened in Ferrara. Visitors are advised to book their visit at least one day in advance and in most cases, it is compulsory to book at weekends and during national holidays. This avoids unnecessary queuing and crowds. A specific website has been created to facilitate this, which you can find below, and booking is free of charge.

Admittance to museums and galleries is limited to a small number of visitors at any given time and staff check that members of the public respect the Covid rules in force and wear a mask, keep a safe distance and sanitize hands. This is to ensure that everyone can enjoy their visit in a safe environment.
