## Estate Bambini - Children's Summer Festival

### Programme:

Monday 2nd - 'Bella, Bellissima!' (3yrs +) a puppet theatre performance.

Tuesday 3rd - 'Legami' (5yrs +) This play takes a look at the relationships between people through the world of a contemporary circus

Wednesday 4th - 'Un tuffo all'insù' (4/5 yrs +) explore the theme of mutual acceptance and collaboration.



Thursday 5th - 'Jack, il ragazzino che sorvolò l'oceano' (4yrs +) is a story based on the adventures of Charles Lindbergh, the first pilot to cross the Atlantic Ocean alone.

Saturday 6th - 'Piccoli principi e principesse' (3yrs +) is a show which plays with mirrors and invisible string.

### Interno Verde - Ferrara's Secret Gardens

14th & 15th September 10 a.m. - 1 p.m. & 3 p.m. - 7 p.m.

Each year, the association 'Il Turco' organizes a special weekend in Ferrara, called 'Interno Verde', where it is possible for the public to visit some of Ferrara's secret gardens. You will be amazed at how many hidden green areas there actually are in our town!

€11 entitles you to a 'kit completo' which includes a bracelet (a two-day pass giving you access to all gardens for the whole weekend), a map and a programme. Children under the age of 13 are free.

It is worth purchasing tickets online before the event as you only pay €11 instead of €15. An interesting book about the gardens, which includes photos, can be bought online for €7. Just add it to the shopping cart.

You can also buy last-minute tickets on the weekend of the event, which cost €15 in total for both days, from the info point in Parco Pareschi, Corso Giovecca 148.

Six days of magic where Ferrara's Parco Massari turns into a magical fairytale land. Admission to the park is free. Donations are welcomed and proceeds go to the local Association 'Giulia ODV' which supports families with children who have cancer.



In the park, you can meet a variety of fairytale characters and take part in different games, take photos, watch shows, visit the mediaeval area, the arts and crafts market and listen to magical stories. There are plenty of things to see and do which are free of charge. Some of the workshops, activities and puppet shows however, are not and you must buy tickets in advance. These are listed at the bottom of the page of the official website in red. Click on 'Cliccate Qui' to book and buy tickets. For the large Lego area and bouncy castle zone, tickets can be bought directly at the park. As always, there is a food area and this year you can stop for lunch, dinner or a snack at the Street Food area.

## 'I Pirati del Po' – Ferrara in Fiaba

A new fairytale event which sounds particularly fun is 'I Pirati del Po' (The Pirates of the Po River), an interactive pirate adventure along the river Po on the 'Nena' motor boat. # Ferrara – Sagra del Pinzino e Arrosticini

1st - 8th September

Centro Sociale Rivana Garden, Via Gaetano Pesci, 181 (off Via Bologna)

Food stand opens at 7 p.m.

'Pinzino' is a delicious, traditional type of fried bread served with salami or other cooked meats. At this fair you can also try lamb skewers, spare ribs, 'piadine', cheese and meat platters as well as home-made desserts.

## Ferrara - Arrosticini nel Chiostro

1st, 6th, 7th & 8th September San Paolo's cloisters, Via Boccaleone 19 (city centre, opposite the castle) Food stand opens on Friday 8 p.m. Saturday & Sunday 7.30 p.m.

This is a great food fair which everyone can reach as it is in the centre of Ferrara. You can taste typical pasta dishes such as 'Cappellacci' (delicious pumpkin filled pasta), 'Cappelletti' (meat filled pasta) and 'Garganelli' pasta with a yummy cream and sausage sauce.

Main courses include tiny meat skewers 'Arrosticini', liver skewers, mixed grills, lamb burgers, cheese platters and luncheon meat platters.

## Malalbergo - Sagra dell'Ortica

1st, 5th, 6th, 7th & 8th September Piazza Primo Carlini 1, Malalbergo (Bo) Open every evening at 7 p.m.

At this food festival you can try a variety of imaginative dishes featuring nettles including risotto, pasta, lasagna and stuffed roast meats. The village is just outside Ferrara on the way to Bologna and it is well-worth the journey.

# Francolino - La Sagra di Santa Liberata

19th – 22nd & 26th – 29th September Via Calzolai, behind the main church Opens at 7 p.m. Live music every evening at 9 p.m.

This traditional Ferrarese food festival is only a bike ride away from Ferrara. From school, head towards Malborghetto on Via Calzolai using the cycle path, which will take you all the way to Francolino.

Enjoy a variety of traditional Ferrarese starters and main courses plus homemade typical desserts including 'Salame al cioccolata' (a wonderfully rich biscuit and chocolate cake in the shape of a salami) 'Zuppa inglese' (which translates as an 'English trifle' as it has a similar custard layer but it also has includes some Italian 'secrets' which make it a rather alcoholic dessert!), 'Tenerina' (a deliciously 'soft' chocolate cake) and of course Italy's famous 'Tiramisu'.

A children's menu is available.
